SNOW SHOE GUN CLUB RULES

1. You **MUST** lock the gate upon entering and exiting!! The only exception will be in the event of scheduled competition or training sessions. The lock will be tagged indicating an open range for the above purposes.
2. Observe all posted range rules.
3. As a member of the Snow Shoe Gun Club, the range belongs to you; common sense and constant attention to firearm safety will allow the continued use of this fine facility.
4. Eye and ear protection must be worn by shooters and all spectators.
5. No one shall handle firearms while others are downrange.
6. Firing on ranges must be downrange only.
7. Unless firing has commenced, all actions will remain open, with magazines removed from those that have detachable magazines.
8. Before firing on the range, make sure no one is down range as the terrain on the rifle range can hide even a vehicle in certain spots. **MAKE SURE!**
9. Do not loan your range key to anyone. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!** Club members may bring guests to the club. Members are responsible for their guest. Members must have their membership card with them when on the range. Range officers will check for membership cards. Please cooperate.
10. Use each range for the intended purpose, i.e. rifle shooting on the rifle range, pistol shooting on the pistol range, etc. Pistol range is used for authorized combat shotgun and sub-machine gun training. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD RIFLES OR PISTOLS BE USED AT THE TRAP RANGE.**
11. Scheduled matches and classes have priority over other range use.
12. Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when on club property. Members are responsible for the safety and actions of all children they bring to the range.
13. Anyone operating a motor vehicle on club property is responsible for that vehicle and must possess a valid drivers license.
14. Grazing moose or caribou have range priority (except during hunting season.)
15. Be considerate of shooters on the firing line; keep conversation low and away from firing points. Do not touch other shooters firearms or equipment without permission. Do not bother shooters when they are at the firing line; distractions cause accidents.
16. Pallets will no longer be allowed for use as target stands on the pistol range. Please be prepared to bring your own portable stands and take them with you when you are finished shooting.
17. No alcohol allowed on the range premises.
18. Keep off the berms at the pistol range.
19. Report any vandalism or unsafe gun handling to range officer or call club president or secretary.
20. Anyone found in violation of these rules may be subject to expulsion.
21. **RANGE HOURS ARE 6:00 A.M. - 10:00 P.M. WE SUGGEST TO STOP SHOOTING AT 9:00 P.M. ON SCHOOL NIGHTS.**
