

# Snowshoe Gun Club Rules

1. The gate must be locked upon entering and exiting the range. The only exception is when the gate is opened for scheduled events, and the lock is tagged indicating an open range for the event.
2. All posted safety and club rules must be followed.
3. As a member of the Snowshoe Gun Club the range belongs to you. Common sense and observation of all firearm safety rules will allow continued use of our fine facility. Make safety your first priority when using the range.
4. Eye and ear protection use are required for all shooters and spectators.
5. No one shall handle firearms while others are down range.
6. Firing must be down range only.
7. Unless firing has commenced, actions must remain open, with magazines removed from those that have detachable magazines.
8. Before firing on the range, make sure no one is down range as the terrain on the rifle range can hide even a vehicle in certain spots. **MAKE ABSOLUTELY CERTAIN!**
9. Do not loan your range key to anyone. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!** Club members may bring guests to the club. Member are responsible for their guests. Member just have their membership card with them when on the range. Range officers will check for membership cards. Please cooperate.
10. Use each range for the intended purpose, i.e. rifle shooting on the rifle range, pistol shooting on the pistol range, etc. Pistol range is used for authorized combat shotgun and sub-machine gun training. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD RIFLES OR PISTOLS BE USED AT THE TRAP RANGE!**
11. Scheduled matches and classes have priority over other range use.
12. Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when on club property. Members are responsible for the safety and actions of all children they bring to the range.
13. Anyone operating a motor vehicle on club property is responsible for that vehicle and must possess a valid driver's license.
14. Grazing moose or caribou have range priority (except during hunting season).
15. Be considerate of shooter on the firing line; keep conversation low and away from firing points. Do not touch other shooters' firearms or equipment without permission. Do not bother shooters when they are at the firing line; distractions cause accidents.
16. Pallets will no longer be allowed for use as target stands on the pistol range. Please be prepared to bring your own portable stands, and take them with you when you are finished shooting.
17. No alcohol is allowed on the range premises.
18. Keep off the berms at the pistol range.
19. Report any vandalism or unsafe gun handling to the range officer, or call the club president or secretary.
20. Anyone found in violation of these rules may be subject to expulsion.
21. **RANGE HOURS ARE 6:00 AM – 10:00 PM. WE SUGGEST TO STOP SHOOTING AT 9:00 PM ON SCHOOL NIGHTS.**
